SUMMER UPDATES

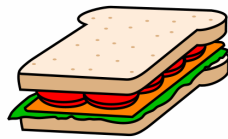
The Summer heat means our Steam Show is right around the corner!

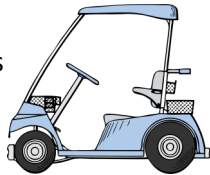
Admission wrist bands must be worn at all times!!!

Advanced reservations will be accepted after Aug 1st by visiting our website or by calling Pat @(715)965-3839.

When you arrive, please stop at Camper Registration first!

You will need to register your camper and/or your PTV, pay your camping fee of \$40.00 and your weekend wristbands before parking your camper!

If the Camping Office is closed for the night, please **PARK YOUR CAMPER ON THE SOUTH END** of the parking area near the loading dock. All campers must first be registered **BEFORE YOU PARK** and **THEN YOU WILL BE ESCORTED TO YOUR SPOT!** Wristbands will be available to purchase at camper registration.

Above all, please be respectful of your camping neighbors!
