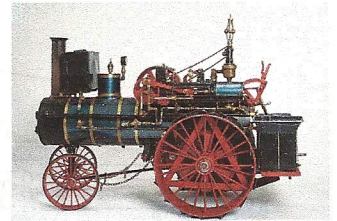

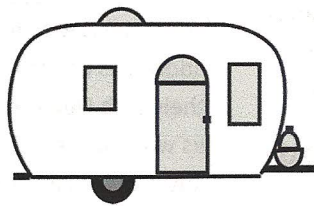
Youth Building
