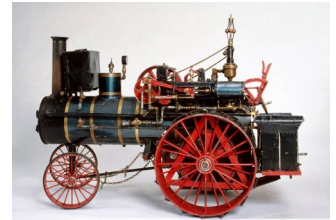

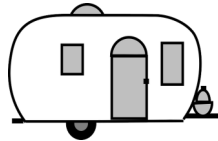
MEMBERSHIP SCHEDULE
