## Fees

Admittance fees are \$6 per day per person and are collected at the gate upon your arrival. Children 12 and under are free when accompanied by an adult.

Exhibitors showing equipment receive 2 admission passes when they register. If you attempt to park your camper before receiving your passes you may be asked to pay the admittance fees and must see campground personnel for a refund.

While we do not charge a set fee for camping, we ask that you please make a free-will donation for each camping unit in addition to the show admittance fees. Thank you for your generosity.

## Camper Registration

1. Camper registration hours are 7 a.m. – 9 p.m. beginning on Tuesday.
2. Anyone camping before those hours will need to park in the parking lot and wait for registration to open the following morning.
3. No early parking of campers without approval or assistance of camping personnel. Persons doing so may be asked to move or may be removed from the show grounds.
4. Registered campers must have registration number visible in camper window or taped to the outside of the camper.
5. Security personnel will be on duty at night and will be assisted by the Marathon County Sherriff Department if necessary.

## Campground Rules

1. No black or gray water may be discharged on grounds at any time. This is strictly prohibited.
2. **Quiet hours from 10:30 p.m. – 6:30 a.m.** No loud noises, music, barking dogs, or generators. **Warning:** If used incorrectly, portable generators can cause carbon monoxide poisoning, electric shock, fires and burns. Only run your generator in a well ventilated area and make sure the exhaust is placed in a well ventilated area and make sure the exhaust is placed far from other campers and tents.
3. **No motorized vehicles in campground during quiet hours.** This includes tractors, garden tractors, ATVs, gators etc. The only exception will be club operated shuttles.
4. Camp fires are permitted **FOR COOKING PURPOSES ONLY** and must be in above ground containers. Do not leave unattended or smoldering fires. Extinguish completely. No fires during quiet hours.

5. Dogs must be **kept on a leash** on show grounds AND in camping area. You **must** pick up all droppings and dispose of properly. Also, please control barking dogs.
6. No sales displays are allowed in the campground. If you have bought items for sale you are required to set up in the flea market area and pay accordingly.
7. Only handicapped or disabled people will be allowed to camp in designated handicap camping area.
8. Parking extra vehicles is allowed only if they fit in your camp space. No parking is allowed in the driving lanes. Extra vehicles need to park in the general parking lot.
9. Visitors to anyone in the campground should park in the general parking lot, pay the admittance fee, and ride shuttles to the campground.
10. Please pick up and dispose of all trash and garbage properly. Help keep all areas clean.
11. Anyone reserving extra sites must have permission from camper registration personnel.

**Violators of any of the above rules risk being immediately and permanently removed from our show grounds, and may lose their club membership if applicable.**
