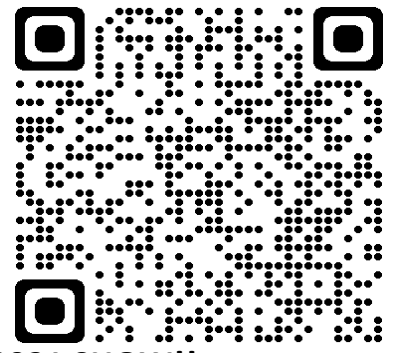


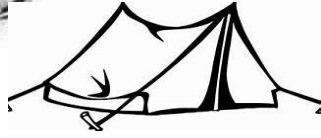

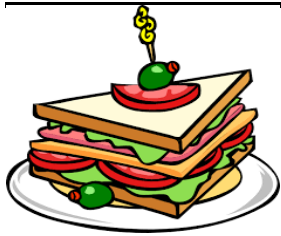
## LEADERSHIP CANDIDATES WANTED
