CLUB MISSION STATEMENT: Our mission is to preserve our rural, agricultural, forestry, and homesteading heritage and to educate future generations in all aspects of that heritage. We do this in many ways during our show.

WELCOME to our Club. We look forward to getting to know you and your family. Please join us at our Membership meetings. You are entitled to a copy of our bylaws. There is a copy in the show school office for your review. If you wish to receive a copy via email, please check the box on the Information form. You must provide an email address.

MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS: All members are encouraged to attend and participate in Membership meetings. This is YOUR Club. We expect you to be part of the future direction for our Club. Your participation in Meetings keeps you abreast of Board activities as well as major projects or show developments. Meetings are held in the Youth Building on our grounds. Meeting dates are:

March & April	3rd Sunday of month at 1 pm
May-July	3rd Monday of month at 7 pm
August	1st Mtg--2 wks before Show week--Monday evening at 7 pm
August	2nd Mtg--Monday evening of Show week at 7 pm---right before the Show.
October	1st Saturday of the month at 2 pm (Includes election of Officers/Directors). Banquet to follow at 4 pm for members wishing to attend. Must pre-register for banquet.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: All memberships are now yearly, after paying your one-time fee of \$100. To maintain active status yearly, you must either complete a minimum of 10 volunteer hours or pay annual dues equal to the weekend gate fee minus \$5, as set by the Board of Directors at the October Board Meeting. The membership year begins two weeks prior to the annual Edgar Steam Show. Volunteer hours worked during the current year's show will count toward the following year's active status. Active members receive free show admission and voting rights. Members who do not meet these requirements will be classified as inactive and will lose membership privileges, voting rights, and eligibility to hold office. Inactive members attending the show must pay regular gate admission. This does not count toward regaining active status. Inactive members may return to active status in any future year by meeting the active member requirements. Reminder that it is the members responsibility to have their hours verified by the chairperson you are working under.
