****ATTENTION EVERYONE****
NEW DIRECTIONS TO OUR 2022 Show
Only on Friday, Saturday & Sunday

New this year, traffic coming to the show grounds from the East on Hwy N is being rerouted to better handle the heavy congestion during our Show. This alternate route will relieve the long traffic lines experienced in the past on Hwy N. Our Board of Directors worked in cooperation with County Sherriff's Dept & Wien Township to assess the traffic safety concerns that present with the heavy traffic coming to our show grounds from the East on Hwy N.

EVERYONE coming to the Show is asked to please use this new route. This includes ALL MEMBERS, Vendors, Exhibitors, and volunteers. EVERYONE needs to use this route please.

NEW ROUTE:

So when you come from the East on Hwy N--you will turn left onto Hwy H. Drive to the 2nd crossroad and turn Right onto Four Mile Road. Proceed to Steam Hill Drive and turn Right. Our Show Grounds will be just ahead. **This is only during the Show--Friday, Saturday & Sunday.**

You will not be allowed to turn onto Steam Hill Dr. from the East.

Members-- Please LEAD BY EXAMPLE

Everyone will follow your lead--so on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, please use the new route when coming from East.

Before & After Our Show:

During the week, normal traffic on Steam Hill is open for use, but Friday, Saturday & Sunday of the Show, we ask everyone to **please follow the directions above when coming from the East.** (Traffic from West is unchanged--same as in the past.)

Online Sign Up begins Aug 1st!

You asked for it--so we did it! New this year, our Club is offering ONLINE SIGN UP for volunteers at our show!!

What this means is you can sign up to help at the Steam Show on our Volunteer Sign up webpage from your smart phone or computer or laptop.

You can find the sign up web links on our Club webpage or Facebook page. You simply click the link of the Dept you wish to help out, and the schedule signup page will open.

On the webpage, you will find:

1. Area or Dept Manager's name and contact info.
2. A brief description of what you will be expected to do.
3. A schedule listing of time-blocks. (It will be very easy to see if a block is taken or open as names will be listed.)

**You are also able to sign up to help by calling the Manager Volunteer Coordinator-- same as in the past.

Fuel Limits during the Show

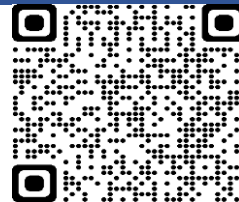


In light of the extreme cost of fuel this year, fueling operations at Tractor Registration will be restricted and watched very closely. Mr. Duane Bender will be supervising fueling this year. The Fuel Supervisor will:

1. Record the name of person fueling.
2. Verify the use and Dept for the fueling.
3. Limit all fuelings to 5 gallons each per fueling.
4. Verify any questionable fuel requests.

Camping Reminders

Advanced reservations will be accepted on **August 1st** (and not before). You will find the web link on our Club webpage. (Or call Pat after August 1st 715-409-3742).

**Attn Campers--When you arrive to camp:

1. Stop at Camper Registration Building.
2. Register your camper & pay \$50 camping fee.
3. Be escorted to your site. Do NOT proceed without escort.
4. If Camping Office is closed--Park in South end of public parking and wait till morning.

**Wristbands will be available to purchase at the Camper Admission gates. See QR code for 2022 Camping Rules.



PTV POLICY applies to ALL PTV's (Electric scooters excluded)

1. Safety first-- be alert for congestion & foot traffic.
2. PTV's MUST register at Tractor Registration
3. Bring proof of insurance & handicap certification.
4. It is recommended to use shuttles vs your PTV please.
5. All PTV's must use lights after dark* (**New Rule**)
6. \$20 fee to operate during peak hours (8 am-6 pm)
7. **Certified** handicapped PTV-- waive fee with approval.
